### Call for student volunteers for the ITS 2012 Conference in Chania/Greece

The Intelligent Tutoring Systems (ITS) 2012 conference, which will take place at Panorama Hotel, in Chania, Crete/Greece, on 14-18 June 2012, is part of an on-going bi-annual series of top-flight international conferences on **technology systems that enable, support or enhance human learning**. All of these tasks will be planned according to a work schedule which will be given to the student volunteers on location.

#### Requirements

Volunteers are expected to have a **positive** and **enthusiastic "can-do"** attitude as well as some **flexibility** and **creativity** in taking care of practical matters. A student volunteer can be an undergraduate, master's, or doctoral student in a field related to the conference's academic discipline **during the 2011-2012 academic year**. **Proficiency in English** is necessary. Earlier experience on student volunteering is not required but would be appreciated.

## Benefits

- All volunteers will be able to attend the conference sessions and workshops, depending on their work schedule. Thus, they will have the opportunity **network** with the most relevant **professionals** and other **students** in the field.
- By the end of the conference, all student volunteers will be given a **certificate of attendance** and a **letter of acknowledgement** of their support.
- Important notice: Coffee breaks and light meals will be offered during the day according to the program. However, **accommodation will not be provided**, so student volunteers should make arrangements on their own cost.
